MEMORANDUM OF CONTINGENCES  
PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION

To the Honorable the Court of \_\_\_\_\_  
The petition of Domènico Gambascio hereby filed, respectfully sheweth:  
First. My place of residence is 1111 11th St (Give number, street, city or town, and State.)  
Second. My occupation is factor  
Third. I was born on the 10 day of May anno Domini 1887, at Lagletta Italy  
Fourth. I emigrated to the United States from Naples Italy on or about the 28 day of March anno Domini 1906, and arrived in the United States, at the port of New York on the 8 day of April anno Domini 1906, on the vessel Luzco  
Fifth. I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 3 day of May anno Domini 1909 at Italy in the West Court of \_\_\_\_\_  
Sixth. I am married. My wife's name is Concetta and she was born in Venafra Italy and now resides in with me  
I have one child, and the name, date and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children is as follows: Mary Aug 9, 1910 born at Italy with me

Seventh. I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my aim to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and early to Victor Emmanuel III King of Italy of which at this time I am a subject, and it is my intention to permanently in the United States.

Eighth. I am able to speak the English language.  
Ninth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least, immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 8 day of April anno Domini 1926, and in the State of Delaware continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since the 9 day of April anno Domini 1926, being a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.

Tenth. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the \_\_\_\_\_ Court of \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_\_ on the \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ anno Domini \_\_\_\_\_, and the petition was denied by the said Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit, \_\_\_\_\_ and the cause of such denial has since been cured or removed.)
